

## SozialMarie 2010 – Requirements / sine qua nons

1. The project that you submit for SozialMarie 2010 must be a social project which stands out in a creative or innovative way. At the time of submission the project must already have been implemented and it must still be running.
2. The submitted project must operate in Austria or Hungary or not further than 300 km (as the crow flies) away from Vienna if it operates in the Czech Republic, Slovakia, Poland, Croatia, Slovenia or Germany.
3. Submission of more than one project is permitted. Such projects must, however, be independent of one another. Please fill in one separate form for each project submitted.
4. Projects submitted in the past can be submitted again provided they have not been awarded a prize.



5. Please fill in the application form in English, German or Hungarian and send it to Unruhe Private Foundation in good time. Should you submit in Hungarian, please supply a translation into German or English. As for time frame, organisational and financial structures, we appreciate concise information. For the project description please absolutely stick to the 3 page-limit.

Should your project make it into the round of the last fifteen, then we would ask you to put pictures at our disposal (for free) for the award ceremony on 1<sup>st</sup> of May 2010, in analogue or digital form.

Winners will not be notified in advance. Which of the projects will win awards will only be announced at the award ceremony on 1<sup>st</sup> of May 2010.
